




National conference on Sustainability in business practices














Webinar: Disruptive marketing










"MUSIQUE MUSHARA"




3 days Finance Conclave on Contemporary Issues Date: December 7 - 9, 2020




Panel Discussion: "HR Challenges for the New World Order"





Panel Discussion: 'Gender Sensitization'






Online Executive Development Program in Business Analytics
